

# ENROLLMENT REQUIREMENTS

Students' continued enrollment at UNC Greensboro is contingent upon completion of the following items.

- If a degree was in progress at the time of submitting the application:
  - One, final official transcript from all colleges and universities where a bachelor's degree and a graduate degree (if required by the program) was earned in the U.S. This transcript must be issued by the registrar's office showing the degree awarded, earned credit hours, GPA, and no courses in progress. If not received before the first week of classes, courses will be dropped and a registration hold will be placed.
  - For international degree(s), an official course-by-course evaluation from a NACES® service, showing proof of earned U.S. equivalency bachelor's degree and a graduate degree (only if required by the program), credit hours, and GPA. Programs may substitute proof of earned U.S. equivalency graduate degree in lieu of U.S. Programs may substitute proof of earned U.S. equivalency graduate degree in lieu of U.S. equivalency bachelor's degree. This evaluation must include degree awarded (verified) equivalency with no courses in progress. If not received before the first week of classes, courses will be dropped and a registration hold will be placed.
- If degree(s) had been awarded at time of application:
  - One final official transcript from all colleges and universities where a bachelor's degree and a graduate degree (if required by the program) were earned in the U.S. This transcript must be issued by the registrar's office showing the degree awarded, earned credit hours, GPA, and no courses in progress and must be received before being allowed to register for the second semester.
  - For international degree(s), an official course-by-course evaluation from a NACES® service, showing proof of earned U.S. equivalency bachelor's degree and a graduate degree (only if required by the program), credit hours, and GPA. Programs may substitute proof of earned U.S. equivalency graduate degree in lieu of U.S. equivalency bachelor's degree. This evaluation must include degree awarded (verified) equivalency with no courses in progress and must be received before being allowed to register for the second semester.
